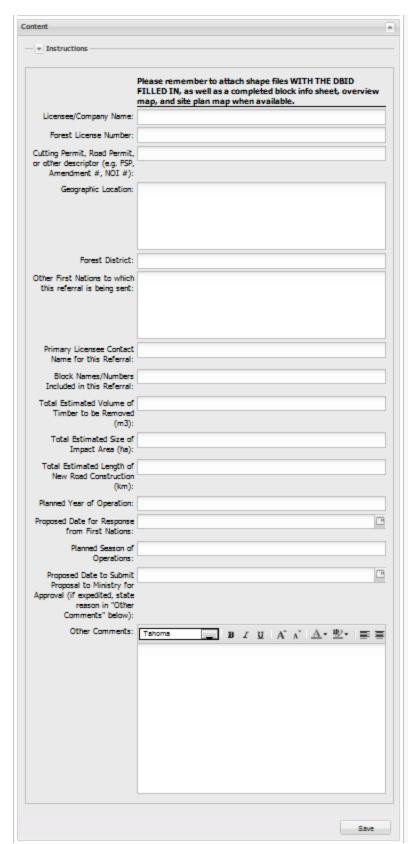

** **NOTE** ** It is very important that <u>all</u> shapefiles are submitted to the portal with the proper DBID attribute filled in based on the parent submission ID.

The steps to generate attributed shape files are:

- Start filling the form, take note of the DBID / Submission ID at the top of the page
- 2. Complete the form fields, and save the content.
- 3. Hold the submission in Draft.
- 4. Complete the shape file attributes including DBID.
- 5. Return to the Portal and go Fill a form Resume Draft.
- Upload your shape files, ensure everything else required is also attached, then Submit the completed form to the Portal.

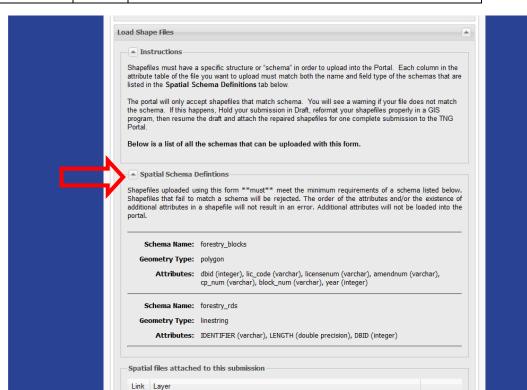


